It is found in all of Europe except the Mediterranean islands and Iceland. The larvae feed on Quercus species, including Quercus robur. They mine the leaves of their host plant. They create a lower-surface tentiform mine. The larva is pale ochreous with a slight bluish tinge. Pupation takes place within the mine.
